GEAR UP Coordinator & GEAR UP Team Responsibilities

The GEAR UP Coordinator is the main contact with the central office for each cluster (the middle and high schools participating in the GEAR UP grant). The GEAR UP coordinator, with the help of their GEAR UP team, is responsible for doing or delegating the following responsibilities:

Communication & Contact Information

GEAR UP Bulletin: The weekly notice of important resources and due dates – just for GEAR UP coordinators and select team members (e-mail dana.beck@oregonstate.edu if you want to add anyone to this list from your school). The bulletin comes out every Tuesday during the school year – coordinators will automatically be added to receive these e-mails. Key info is also included on the Grant Management section of the website.

GEAR UP Newsletter: A general update of college readiness news and research, plus upcoming events, professional development, and grant opportunities delivered each Wednesday during the school year. Some information may be repeated from the bulletin, but much of it is new and useful. Coordinators and administrators are already signed up to receive the newsletter; others are welcome to sign up on the website.

GEAR UP Coordinator’s Facebook Group: (facebook.com/groups/oregongearupcoordinators) Specifically for past and present coordinators (GEAR UP staff are also included, to help answer questions or point to resources as needed). Ask questions, share ideas, and upload files. The group is "closed" for privacy.

GEAR UP Website: The main GEAR UP website at oregongearup.org has resources for educators (and to a lesser extent, students and parents) on preparing and paying for college, as well as information about our program and the schools we serve.
